Things to know before you apply:

- 1. Editable pdf versions of the application are available at chrispotvinfund.org
- 2. Your application should be submitted simultaneously with letters of recommendation if possible. If a school needs to send letters separately, that is permissible as well. <u>Letters should be addressed to the Christopher Potvin Scholarship Fund</u>. These should be from:
 - a. A coach or other mentor/influential person in athletics.
 - b. Administration or Guidance Department from your school.
 - c. Other non-related persons who can attest to your character, sportsmanship, community involvement or outstanding recognition, etc.
- 3. Applications must be submitted by May 1, 2025.
